BARRED FROM LEAVING THE COUNTRY FOR TAX
DEFAULTERS

Effective October 2013 the Inland Revenue Board of Malaysia (IRBM) will intensify its efforts to target taxpayers who fail to pay their outstanding tax debt.

Following the issuance of a reminder letter and notice of outstanding tax to the tax defaulter, he/she will be prevented from leaving the country under Section 104 of the Income Tax Act 1967 (ITA 1967) and Section 22 of the Real Property Gains Tax Act 1976 (RPGTA 1976), unless and until he/she pays all the tax debts.

The stoppage order is invoked only after various attempts to collect tax arrears have failed due to resistance by the tax defaulter.
